Career Opportunities

Program Background: In 2017, MRCS is increasing its engagement in Rakhine state through immediate, medium and long-term support to people affected by communal violence. With the support of IFRC, ICRC MRCS has initiated Rakhine Operations Management Unit program in Sittwe, Mrauk–U, Kyauktaw, Ponnagyun, Minbya, Maungdaw, Buthidaung, and Rathedaung Townships. Program period is initial three months and high possibility of extension as long-term program. Maungdaw, Buthidaung, and Rathedaung areas are under the management of Maungdaw Hub office. MRCS is setting up Operation Management Unit.

Purpose of this position: We are looking for a skilled Mechanic to assemble, maintain and repair machinery and vehicles. You will be responsible for ensuring functionality and reliability of machines, engines and mechanical systems of various machines and tools as well as follow all safety precautions. You will diagnose vehicles based on observational and mechanical testing as well as information provided by the driver and then provide assistant fleet officer with detailed estimates for repairs and replacements. Repair vehicles based on the diagnosed issues and repair

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estimate cost. Test drive vehicles after repairs are complete to ensure mechanical soundness and to determine whether any other problems exist. Describe vehicle's condition to supervisors, Drivers and answer any follow-up questions. File appropriate documentation on each repair.

Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. To ensure MRCS policies and guidelines and properly followed.
- 2. Build and assemble machines or mechanical components according to requirements.
- 3. Inspect machines, engines, transmissions etc. and run diagnostic tests to discover functionality issues.
- 4. Conduct repairs aiming for maximum reliability.
- 5. Troubleshoot reported problems and resolve them in a timely manner.
- 6. Perform thorough maintenance on machinery, equipment and systems.
- 7. Clean and apply lubricants to machinery components.
- 8. Replenish fluids and components of engines and machinery.
- 9. Provide consultation on correct maintenance and preventative measures to machine or vehicle users.
- 10. Undertake other duties as assigned (e.g. repair of hydraulic systems, painting vehicles etc.)
- 11. Keep logs of work and report on issues.

- Minimum high school completion is required with relevant technical certificate is preferred
- Excellent knowledge of machinery and hydraulic, electrical and other systems and their components
- Must have the excellent driving skills and update driving license

- Ability to follow established procedures and practices and read instruction, blueprints etc
