Myanmar Red Cross Society (MRCS) is volunteer based humanitarian organization throughout the whole country acting with and for the most vulnerable at all times. Benefit Package consists of Paid Medical, Annual, Casual Leave, Insurance, On-Duty for Training, Provide Accommodation Allowance & Hardship Allowance for specific area, Training and Development Opportunities, Promotion and Management Development.

Background: In 2017, MRCS is increasing its engagement in Rakhine state through immediate, medium and long-term support to people affected by communal violence. MRCS is setting up Operation Management Unit. Sittwe Township area are under the management of Sittwe Hub office. MRCS in collaboration with the Norwegian Red Cross is planning on implementing a Health programme in Central Rakhine State. The program seeks to contribute primary health care services to communities both directly and indirectly affected by communal violence. The project will target Sittwe township in Rakhine State. The project will

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strengthen Myanmar Red Cross Society (MRCS) capacity to engage communities in resilience programming through primary health care services, training and awareness building. The project will also seek to address an observed need of health services and lack of awareness surrounding hygiene practices in villages through direct interaction with community members. MRCS is seeking a Health Officer to join this team. Program period is initial three months and high possibility of extension as long-term program.

Purpose of the position: The Medical Doctor will be the senior member of one of the MRCS mobile clinic team's operation in Sittwe Township, Rakhine State, providing primary medical care to populations affected by communal conflict and displacement. Mobile clinics will travel to different locations on a rotating basis, as guided by the State Health Department/Ministry of Health. The Medical Doctor is responsible for the field operations of the mobile clinic, ensuring that health services are provided to the targeted community, supervising the other members of the mobile team (Nurses and Red Cross Volunteer local aid workers) as well as coordinating with State Health Department (SHD), local community and Internal Displace People (IDP) camp leaders, and other organizations providing health care as necessary.

Duties and Responsibilities

I. Clinical Care

1. Ensure MRCS policies and guidelines are properly followed.
2. Provide appropriate clinical care to all patients, including diagnosis and treatment of prevalent diseases.
3. Determine when a patient should refer to higher care facilities and proper referral ensured.
4. Ensure patient's regular attendance to clinic and to monitor progress and side effects.
5. Organize the patient appointment book, registers and regular follow-up schedule.
6. Address other health needs of the patients in general.
7. Maintain clear and complete documentation on patients.
8. Perform home care visits when and where necessary.

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II. General management and coordination

9. Coordinate with other members of the multi-disciplinary team surrounding each patient.
10. Ensure the overall smooth functioning and integration of the various activities in the clinic.
11. Collaborate with the program coordination team on all project related matters.
12. Assess needs for medicines and medical materials for ordering, in collaboration with nurse and ensure proper supply of drugs, medical and logistics supplies at clinic level.
13. Deal and negotiate with local authorities as needed.
14. Lead the clinic meetings.
15. Signal and initiate improvements in the functioning of the clinic.

III. Data collection and reporting

16. To ensure the correct, complete and timely collection of relevant data.
17. To support the Health Program Coordinator in monitoring to clinic activities and analyse relevant data.
18. To support the Health Program Coordinator to compile activity reports on a regular basis.
19. To ensure that stock registers/ patient registers/reports/analysis, in collaboration with nurses and volunteers, are done correctly and systematically and that numbers are medically pertinent

Skills, Competencies and Requirements

- **Must be a Myanmar National**
- **Age under 50 years old**
- Medical degree with Valid license and official registration
- Working experience with other INGO/local NGO in mobile clinic
- Permission order on resignation from respective line department/military is to be attached if the applicant has ever served in a government department/ military
- Motivated to work in the field /camp
- Proven management/supervision skills

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- Good computer skills (Microsoft Office Package)
- Flexibility and Support to Emergency Intervention
- Interest in learning about the Red Cross/Red Crescent Movement
- Effective command of English, both written and spoken
- Skilling the local language would be more appropriate is preferable
