**Background**: In 2017, MRCS is increasing its engagement in Rakhine state through immediate, medium and long-term support to people affected by communal violence. With the support of IFRC, MRCS has initiated Branch Capacity Building Development program in Sittwe, Mrauk-U, Kyauktaw, Ponnagyun, Minbya, Maungdaw, Buthidaung, and Rathedaung Townships. Program period is initial three months and high possibility of extension as long-term program.

Maungdaw, Buthidaung, and Rathedaung areas are under the management of Maungdaw Hub office. MRCS is setting up Operation Management Unit.

Purpose of the position: The Livelihood Field Officer will be responsible for field implementation of the Northern areas of Rakhine, Livelihood Programmme supported by International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Socities. The project concern to implement direct and indirect affected community in August 2017 situation in Maungdaw, Rakhine State.He/she will contribute to ensuring that all activities are implemented in line with the project goal, objectives and output indicators. He/she will be based in Maungdaw, as part of the Rakhine Operations Management Unit, Maungdaw Hub Office team, and will work under the direct supervision of the MRCS Livelihood Project Officer (PO).

## **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Contribute to rapid assessments of communities to select project locations; and Integrated Community Assessment for Building Resilience (ICABR) with communities to agree project options and targeting criteria
- 2. Implement activities in communities in line with the livelihoods log-frame and Plan of Action, including:
  - Beneficiary Household assessments, cross-checking the selection criteria and the situation of beneficiaries
  - 2. Drafting of business plans with volunteers and beneficiaries
  - 3. Procurement process with involvement of beneficiaries as much as possible, where relevant
  - 4. Delivery of in kind or cash inputs; or cash-for-work projects
  - 5. Monitoring of activities and income generation and household economy situation

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- 6. Coaching of beneficiaries during the establishment and development of their productive activities
- 7. Organize the technical skill training for livelihood related community.
- 3. Provide technical guidance to township branch volunteers to support the field implementation
- 4. Select community members to act as project mobilisers in locations where RCVs will not be working.
- 5. Contribute to the preparation of detailed plans and budgets for the livelihood activities under the guidance of the Project Officer.
- 6. Prepare monthly progress reports and share with PO before the agreed deadlines
- 7. Prepare cash forecast based on plan of action and send to PO before agreed deadlines
- 8. Conduct field visits, monitor project progress and ensure timely implementation of project activities in line with project log frame and plan of action
- Ensure that project implementation is in line with MRCS strategy, policies and the Red Cross Fundamental Principles and Code of Conduct
- 10. Collaborate and coordinate with other Livelihood Officer based in Rakhine to share experiences and standardize tools and approaches
- 11. Carry out any other tasks assigned by the Project Officer
