### **Background of the Project**

Myanmar Red Cross Society (MRCS) has received fund from IFRC to enable humanitarian recovery from emergencies for vulnerable disaster-affected communities through more efficient provision of relief supplies in Myanmar.In 2024 the MRCS is constructing a new warehouse in Magway to store supplies required to meet humanitarian needs of the Region during the times of complex emergency.

#### **Purpose of the Position**

The job purpose of the **Construction Monitoring Engineer** is to monitor and report construction progress and any issues that arise as instructed by Logistics Manager of Logistics and Supply Chain Management (the Contract Manager) on behalf of the MRCS. This role will oversee the work done by the contractor on site during the complete construction process.

This position is within Myanmar Red Cross Society (MRCS) based on site in Magway Township, Magway Region.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities**

### **Technical**

1. Co-ordinate the timely collection of "As-Built" or "As-Constructed" information for record purposes including operational manual, test report, etc.

- 2. To ensure that a set of approved plans/permit and available on site. To highlight any discrepancies found between disciplines or within the same discipline prior to the commencement of construction.
- 3. To check through construction drawings and highlight and discrepancies found between or within the same disciplines prior to the commencement of installation works.
- 4. To be well-versed with status and scope of works and co-ordinate by liaising with the Contractor and Consultants.
- 5. To ensure that the required standards of quality and accuracy are maintained for all works and conform to the contract specifications, construction drawings, approved materials and statutory regulations. All tolerances shall be in accordance with the technical specifications.
- 6. To notify the Engineer & Project Manager of any deviations from the approved shop drawings, authorities' approval drawings and specifications immediately.
- 7. To ensure all materials used conform to specifications.
- 8. Ensure adequate safety precautions are enforced on site.
- 9. To witness recording of geotechnical measurements, instrumentation and material tests.
- 10. To monitor progress on the works and report weekly on appropriate forms to the Engineer/ Architect/Client highlighting all delays, problems encountered and resolutions to problems.
- 11. To ensure minimum safety measures (such as safety boots, helmets, gloves, etc) are in place at construction site at all time.
- 12. Attend site meetings as directed by the consultant or logistics Manager.
- 13. To verify Contractor's site progress report and other documents as required.
- 14. To assist the Engineer with suggestions in construction / installation detail or another site problem.
- 15. Prepare and up-date a list of outstanding / non-compliance works to floor by floor or Area by Area whichever is more suitable to the Engineer for discussion at site meeting/ co-ordination meeting.
- 16. Assist the Client's site representative to ensure that the site and completed installation are left clean.

17. Determination to see a job to its rightful conclusion.
